The Audubon Public School District will again be offering a **free** preschool program for Audubon and Audubon Park four year old children at the Haviland Avenue School for the 2012/2013 school year. This Integrated Preschool Class will enroll preschoolers with disabilities, along with typically developing children, in order to provide public school opportunities according to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. We are looking to recruit typically developing children for this class who will be **four** by October 1, 2012 and we do not accept children who have turned five by that date. The program will run three days per week: Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, from 12:10 to 2:40 p.m. No transportation will be provided for general education students. Children should be toilet trained and have age-appropriate verbal skills. Selection for the program will be by lottery. The Audubon Public Schools invites you to apply for a **free** preschool program to be held at the Haviland Avenue School for the 2012/2013 school year. Half-day classes will provide developmentally appropriate instruction for four year old children, including those with disabilities.

There is **NO COST** for this program and **NO TRANSPORTATION IS PROVIDED**. We are looking for four year old children who are developing typically to serve as role models for children with special needs. Class size will be limited, with a dually certified teacher and an instructional aide. Included in the program will be integrated speech/language therapy, physical therapy, and occupational therapy services. This program will benefit all children.

To apply, complete the form below and return it **NO LATER THAN** Friday, January 27, 2012 to the Child Study Team Office at Audubon High School. Please bring proof of residency (i.e., a utility bill, mortgage coupon, lease) and your child's birth certificate. We are seeking typically developing children who are toilet trained and residents of Audubon or Audubon Park. We will notify parents of selected children by February 3, 2012.
