Dear Parent/Guardian:

As many of you are already aware, our recent budget difficulties have resulted in the decision to implement an activity fee for students involved in non-service related extracurricular activities.

Attached please find the form to be used for payment. Please identify the sport or extracurricular activity in which your child will participate. It is important to note that once a child starts a season or activity, they will be expected to complete the activity and money will only be reimbursed if the child is removed from the team for reasons outside of academic or disciplinary penalties. Any activities not sponsored and financially supported by the Audubon Board of Education will not be subject to the aforementioned fees. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunches will be exempt from the activity fee. Before a student may participate in any activity, he/she must submit the attached form to the Athletic Office with other required paperwork. As has always been the case, physical forms may be obtained in the Athletic Office or on our district website.
