What Vaccines are available?

Tdap	For 19 to 64 years of age. It is a <u>one time</u> substitute for a Td booster. May be given as short as 2 years from previous Td booster. (Tetanus,
	Diphtheria and Pertussis)
	For men and women 19 to 26 years of age. It is a series of 3 doses.
HPV	(Human Papillomavirus)
	Up to 2 doses for <i>high risk people ages 19 to 64</i> with a minimum of 5
Pneumonia	years between doses. For people over 65 only one dose is required.
	For individuals 19-55 years of age at increased risk for meningococcal
Meningitis	disease are recommended to be vaccinated including college freshman
	living in dormitories, laboratory personnel working with the bacteria, military
	personnel, certain travelers, or those that are immune compromised.

- Vaccine supply is not guaranteed. For more information call 856/931-2700.
- Pneumonia vaccine is for high risk individuals which include those that have a compromised immune system, diabetes, heart disease, chronic lung disease, chronic alcoholism, chronic liver disease, spleen disease/removal, or kidney failure.
- Proof of prior pneumonia immunization will be required if a second dose is requested.
- Must be a New Jersey resident.
