EMPLOYEE TUBERCULIN TESTING

New Jersey State Law requires that anyone working with school age students be TB tested.

The rules of the State Department of Education require use of the <u>MANTOUX</u> intradermal test. In the event of a <u>positive reaction</u>, proof of a negative chest x-ray or a written medical evaluation from your family physician <u>must be shown</u> <u>prior to employment</u>.

If you do not have a <u>MANTOUX</u> documented within the past six (6) months, have your family doctor give and record below. Please return this form to the Superintendent's Office in the high school.

If you have been employed in a New Jersey Public School, or, if you are transferring between school districts within New Jersey and have a documented record on a **MANTOUX TB TEST**, please submit a copy of it to this office.

This is a **State requirement** and must be on record before you are employed.
