RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON AND THE BOROUGH OF HADDON HEIGHTS REGARDING MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES

WHEREAS, Audubon is a municipal entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County with offices at 606 W. Nicholson Road, Audubon, New Jersey 08106; and

WHEREAS, Haddon Heights is a municipal entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County with offices located at 625 Station Avenue, Haddon Heights, New Jersey 08035; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Haddon Heights ("Haddon Heights") and the Borough of Audubon ("Audubon") are both Local Units and are permitted, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act ("Act"), to enter into an Agreement to provide jointly, or through each respective agency itself, such services authorized by the Act, including areas of general government administration, such as shared services; and

WHEREAS, a fiscal and operational analysis has identified opportunities to further improve the efficiency of the Municipal Court of the Haddon Heights, through the utilization of a Shared Services Agreement with Audubon which shall reduce the cost of services for the respective Local Units; and

WHEREAS, the Local Units have determined it to be in their mutual best interests to provide for a Shared Municipal Court to provide services to their respective Local Units, with the Audubon acting as the Lead Agency; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is established in accordance with the provisions of the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act", P.L.2007, c.63 (C.40A:65-l, et seq.), approved on April 3, 2007 as a means for local units to engage in more efficient operations and services in a cost-effective manner; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c) authorizes municipalities to provide for shared court facilities, courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies, and employees by Resolution, without establishing a joint municipal court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Audubon, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Audubon hereby authorizes and approves the Shared Service Agreement in a form attached hereto and made a part hereof and authorizes the Mayor, Borough Clerk and./or their respective designees to take and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
- 3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4, the subject SSA shall be filed, for informational purposes, with the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, pursuant to rules and regulations promulgated by the Director.
- 4. The Shared Service Agreement shall become effective upon approval of the Assignment Judge of the Camden County Superior Court.
- 5. A copy of the SSA shall be made available for public inspection at the offices of the Borough Clerk upon its effective date.
- 6. The SSA shall take effect upon the adoption of appropriate resolutions by all the parties hereto, and execution of agreements authorized thereunder as set forth in the SSA.
- 7. Any other pre-existing SSA's between the parties, of a similar nature are hereby rendered null and void effective December 31, 2023.

WHEREAS, This program is designed to complement the Community Energy Plan Grant (CEPG) Program and support municipalities in implementing high-priority, high-impact, practical, and cost-effective municipal projects supporting energy resilience, renewable energy, and energy efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon sees a need for this kind of assistance and is eligible as a New Jersey municipal government with a completed and adopted community energy plan; and

FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING OF SODIUM CHLORIDE AND PRETREATED LIQUID ENHANCED SODIUM CHLORIDE, FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, UNDER THE CAMDEN COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM, IDENTIFIER #57-CCCPS

WHEREAS, the County of Camden, as the Lead Aency for the Camden County Cooperative Pricing System, System Identifier #57-CCCPS (Cooperative), awarded BID B-19/2022; Furnishing and Delivering Sodium Chloride, Pretreated Liquid Enhanced Sodium Chloride, Corrosion Inhibited De-icing Liquid and Magnesium Chloride Flakes for Various Locations in Camden County under the Camden County Cooperative Pricing System#57-CCCPS, on an "as Needed" basis and authorized the award of contract to Atlantic Salt, Inc., 134 Middle St., Suite 210, Lowell, MA 01852, at the unit price of \$76.00 per ton for Item No. 1, Sodium Chloride and \$96.00 per ton for Item No. 2, Pre-treated Liquid Enhanced Sodium Chloride, for a term of one (1) year commencing November 30, 2023 through November 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, funding for this purpose shall be contingent upon the availability of and appropriation of sufficient funds in the Borough's permanent 2024 budgets and shall encumbered pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5(b)(2) at the unit price listed in the bid proposals and shall not exceed the County's budgeted line item for the purpose; now, therefore,
