Preschool Parents and Guardians:

I am writing to request your assistance with concerns that have been reported to me regarding safe drop off and pick up. We are fortunate to call Audubon Park home to our preschool, and as such it is important that we respect the rules that apply to the Borough and their space.

Be reminded that:

- There is NO drop off or pick up from the main entrance parking lot. Please park in the back lot and walk to the main entrance. I am receiving calls about safety in this area and am asking for your cooperation to keep everyone safe.
- If you wish to socialize or children wish to play, please feel free to make use of the playground outside of school hours. Note that staff are busy with other responsibilities at this time and are not available to provide care, supervise students, give access to facilities, or meet without an appointment.
- There is no parking on the streets in Audubon Park.
- Designated parking for the municipal building is posted. Do not park in designated parking spaces.
- Additional parking is available on Kennedy Drive if the lot is full.
- There is access to the Black Horse Pike from Kennedy Drive, just past the fire department and housing corporation offices.

Additionally,

- There is no crosswalk or safe crossing on any streets in Audubon Park.
- Do not block driveways or double park.
- Supervise your child(ren) in the parking lot, playground, and athletic field at all times.
- Please do not allow children to play on the ramp, at the municipal building, or near cars in the lot.
- Be respectful of property and dispose of all trash properly.
